Introduction
This hearing was convened to deal with the landlord's application for dispute resolution under the Residential Tenancy Act (the "Act") for an order of possession due to an alleged breach of an agreement.
Background and Evidence
At the hearing, the landlord's agent appeared and presented that the tenant has vacated the rental unit since the filing of the application and that the landlord no longer needed an order of possession.
The landlord's agent agreed that their application should be dismissed.
Conclusion
I therefore dismiss the landlord's application and make no findings on the merits of the application.
