<u>Introduction</u>
This hearing was held in response to the tenant's Application for Dispute Resolution in which the tenant has applied to cancel a 10 Day Notice to End Tenancy for Unpaid Rent.
Both parties were present at the hearing.
The tenant stated he has vacated the unit and that the landlord now has legal possession of the unit.
As the tenant no longer wished to dispute the Notice issued for unpaid rent; he withdrew the application.
This decision is final and binding on the parties, unless otherwise provided under the Act, and is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the <i>Residential Tenancy Act</i> .
