DECISION

<u>Dispute Codes</u> OPR, MNR, MND, FF

Introduction

This matter dealt with an application by the Landlord for an Order of Possession, a monetary Order for unpaid rent, for compensation for damage to the unit site or property and to recover the filing fee for this proceeding.

At the start of the conference call the Landlord was made aware that he did not provide a copy of the Notice to End Tenancy or a copy of the Tenancy Agreement in the evidence. Without a copy of a valid Notice to End Tenancy or a copy of the tenancy agreement to establish grounds that there is a tenancy the Landlord's claims and the application are dismissed with leave to reapply due to a lack of evidence.

Conclusion

The Landlord's application is dismissed with leave to reapply due to a lack of evidence.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the Residential Tenancy Act.
