Introduction

This hearing dealt with an Application for Dispute Resolution by the tenant for the return of the security deposit and pet damage deposit and to recover the filing fee.

The applicant tenant was provided with a copy of the Notice of a Dispute Resolution Hearing after filing their application dated April 08, 2014. The tenant, however, did not attend the hearing set for today at 9:30 a.m. The phone line remained open for fifteen minutes and was monitored throughout this time. The only parties to call into the hearing were the respondent landlords.

Analysis and Conclusion

Following the fifteen minute waiting period, the application of the tenant was dismissed, without leave to reapply.

This decision is final and binding on both parties.
