Introduction and Preliminary Matter

This hearing convened as a result of a Tenant's Application for Dispute Resolution wherein the Tenant sought an Order cancelling a Notice to End Tenancy for Landlord's Use as well as to recover the filing fee.

The Tenant was represented by her counsel, J.S., who also appeared as agent for J.L, counsel for the Landlord. At the outset of the haring J.S. advised that the parties had reached a comprehensive settlement and that accordingly, the Tenant wished to withdraw her application. Accordingly, I record the Tenant's Application as having been withdrawn. I make no findings with respect to the merit of the Tenant's Application.

Conclusion

The parties reached a complete settlement and the Tenant's application is recorded as being withdrawn.
