## **DECISION**

Dispute Codes OPR-DR, MNR-DR, FFL

## <u>Introduction</u>

This hearing dealt with the landlord's application pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "Act") for:

- an order of possession for unpaid rent pursuant to section 55;
- a monetary order for unpaid rent pursuant to section 67;
- authorization to recover the filing fee for this application pursuant to section 72.

This application was originally heard by way of a Direct Request Proceeding and on June 10, 2022, an interim decision was issued adjourning the application to be reconvened at a participatory hearing.

While the respondent attended the hearing by way of conference call, the applicant did not, although I waited until 1:42 p.m. in order to enable the applicant to connect with this teleconference hearing scheduled for 1:30 p.m. The applicant should have been aware of the hearing date, time and call in instructions as this dispute was initiated by the applicant and the applicant was required to serve a copy of the notice of hearing on the respondent.

Accordingly, in the absence of the applicant's participation in this hearing, I order the application dismissed without leave to reapply.

## Conclusion

The application is dismissed without leave to reapply.
